Three Plans for Instruction:

Full-day, all-week in-person instruction:

- ❖ Class size maximized at 18 students
- ❖ Desks arranged 6 feet apart
- ❖ Masks required with breaks
- ❖ Cohort model when using shared space - cafeteria, recess
- ❖ Special area teacher travel into homerooms, except Gym, Library and Music (12 ft separation to sing)
- ❖ Staggered arrival with temperature checks and daily health verification
- ❖ Parents are encouraged to remain in their car.
- ❖ No unnecessary visitors

Optional virtual instruction for immunocompromised students:

- ❖ Class Dojo
- ❖ Google Classroom
- ❖ I-Ready
- ❖ Zoom into live lesson as it is taught in school
- ❖ All support services followed as usual via Zoom and phone call

Distance Learning:

- ❖ Class Dojo
- ❖ Google Classroom
- ❖ I-Ready
- ❖ Zoom live lessons
- ❖ Loom recorded lessons
- ❖ Materials pick-up and drop-off times scheduled monthly

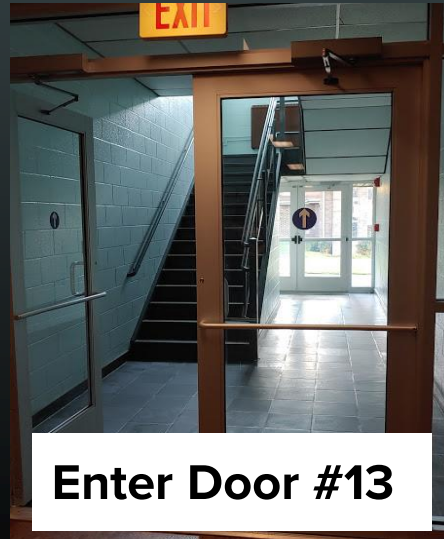

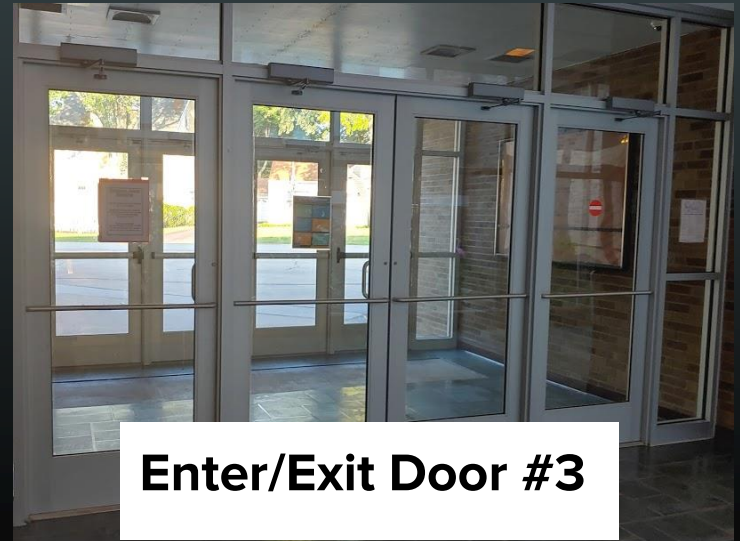
One-Way Stairwells

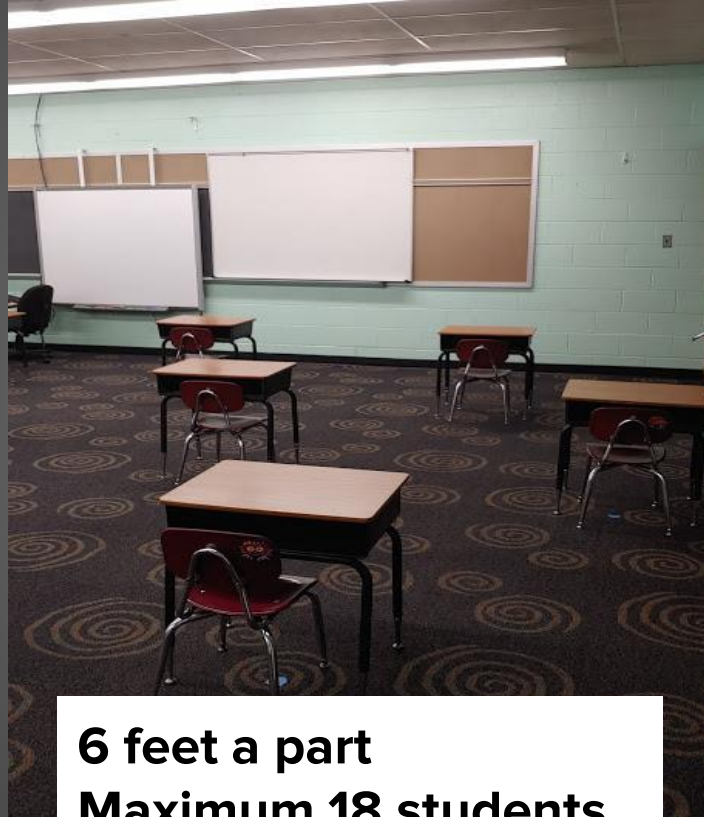
