Did You Know?

The Ambassador Scholarship can be applied to your tuition account more than once each year! When you refer another family who registers a child, you and that family receive \$500 off your tuition.

Refer 2 families – you receive \$1000 off your tuition

Each family who registers with your referral will receive \$500 off their tuition.

Covid-19

The Diocese of Rochester determined late last summer that the Catholic Schools have submitted reopening plans with precautionary protocols making it safe to provide full-time, in-person instruction.

At Saint Ambrose Academy, we require

1. Universal masking regardless of vaccination status
2. Limited class sizes 18-20 students depending on spacing of desks to maintain 6 feet distance between students
3. No unnecessary guests, or volunteers enter the building to engage with students
4. Daily health verification completed by all students, faculty and staff, and temperature taken upon arrival
5. Tours are available after 3:30 when the least number of students are present

6. Increased disinfecting and sanitizing high touch surfaces including furniture, stairwell railings and doorknobs

DO Not wait to re-register. It is anticipated that these protocols will remain in place as we prepare for the 2022-2023 school year.

Free At-home Covid-19 Test Kits

Test kits are distributed to adults only. Car driven children receive their test kit at dismissal. Bus driven children need to have an adult come to school to receive a test kit from the main office.

Weather Closure

Please watch the news channels for any reports of school closures due to poor weather conditions. Saint Ambrose Academy closes automatically if either East Irondequoit Central School District or The Rochester City School District closes due to not having transportation available to our students on those days.

Tardy notice and concerns

Students are expected to arrive at school between 8:00-8:15!

Students are provided a breakfast option each morning. Due to Covid-19 protocols, breakfast is Grab-n-Go style, and the students eat in the classroom.

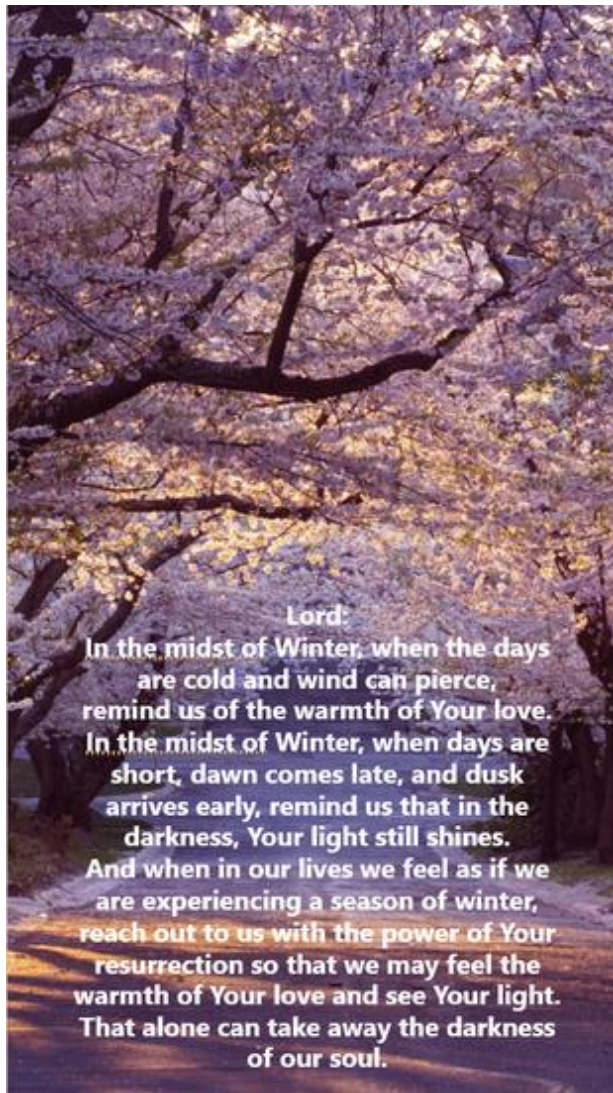
Community Gathering begins in the Gym at 8:20. All students are expected to be at Community Gathering to begin their school day in community prayer and to hear daily announcements.

Curriculum instruction begins at 8:45, following Community Gathering. Breakfast will be open to students until 9:00. At that time, teachers will assume the child has already eaten their breakfast at home. A delayed service of breakfast has negatively impacted the teachers' and students' ability to use every minute productively. Please call the main office if your child is going to arrive at school after 9:00 and needs to receive a breakfast.
