Dear St. Ambrose Academy Family,

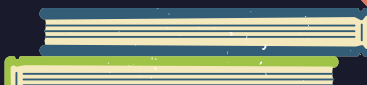
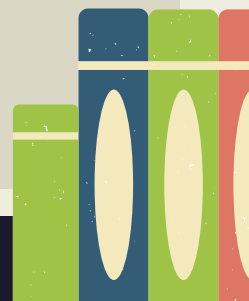
